

Agreement	CCA-EMC-mark	Agreement on the use of commonly agreed Mark of conformity to European Standards for EMC. Associated to EEPCA (European Electrical Product Certification Association). Operating since: April 1997 Statistics: About 320 licenses per Jan. 2002 Secretariat: Mr. Nils Kleinjan, c/o EEPCA, Paris, France Management: CCA-EMC-mark signatory group, meeting at least once a year, in combination with CIG (Common Interest Group). Openness	No geographical limitation for manufacturing.	
Standards	Applicable European EMC standards for compliance with the EMC Directive.	
Fees and Surcharge	Certification/licence fee(s) determined by each signatory. No surcharge is applicable.	
Certification mark	 Common mark for Europe, meaning certification according to European EMC Standards and hence compliance with the EMC Directive. The mark is commonly owned by the signatories. It is internationally registered by IMQ, Italy on behalf of all signatories. Name of the certification body to be included in the mark, (as here for Nemko).	
Secondary application	Not applicable, since representing a common certification for all Europe.	
Secondary test sample	Not applicable, except when requested for product surveillance checks, (i.e. for periodical and random limited tests to verify current product compliance).	
Production surveillance	According to common European procedures CIG 021 Minimum annual follow-up visits + periodical product surveillance checks
